


## Earthquake on April 3, 2024 Taiwan-Taipei

When viewing the 2024 Aries entry with the world map in \*ACG\* mode, it is noticeable that Saturn's MC line is above Taiwan.

According to the old rule that malefic planets at the corner houses possibly mean earthquakes, such an event is possibly indicated here.


The time limitation to the month or day can now be determined with the help of the state horoscope as well as with the Solar (Ingress) by calculating the AS and MC with primary direction. First the WIDDERINGRESS 2024 \*ACG\*




Now the chart of the Ingress with the corresponding primary directions of the axes.


**® NATAL CHART** 




As you can see here, the trigger time is April 3 with the Sun, later on the 5th with Mars. Strong aftershocks may be expected around April 18/19.




The state horoscope of China National 1 shows the following with the calculation of the primary axes:

## Tote und Verletzte nach schwerem Erdbeben

Stand: 03.04.2024 10:17 Uhr

Der Osten Taiwans ist von einem schweren Erdbeben erschüttert worden. Mindestens sieben Menschen kamen dabei ums Leben, mehr als 700 wurden verletzt. Seismologen sprechen vom stärksten Beben in der Region seit 25 Jahren.

In Taiwan hat sich am Morgen gegen 8 Uhr (Ortszeit) das stärkste Erdbeben seit einem Vierteljahrhundert ereignet. Mindestens sieben Menschen starben, wie die nationale Feuerwehrbehörde mitteilte. Mindestens 700 Menschen seien verletzt worden. Außerdem seien 77 Menschen noch in Gebäuden und in Tunneln in der am stärksten betroffenen Stadt Hualien an der taiwanischen Ostküste eingeschlossen, darunter zwei Deutsche. Die beiden befinden sich demnach im Chongde-Tunnel, der im Taroko-Nationalpark liegt.

Das Erdbeben war in ganz Taiwan zu spüren. Taiwans Wetterbehörde registrierte südöstlich der Küste bei Hualien in einer Tiefe von 15,5 Kilometern eine Bebenstärke von 7,2. Die Erdbebenwarte in den USA (USGS) gab eine Stärke von 7,4 in dem Gebiet an, das Epizentrum befand sich demnach 18 Kilometer südlich der Stadt Hualien.
